**New Era of Patient Care Launched at Credit Valley
Hospital officially opens The Carlo Fidani Peel Regional Cancer Centre
and The Ambulatory Care Centre**

Mississauga, ON (CVH) - The Credit Valley Hospital is proud to officially open The Carlo Fidani Peel Regional Cancer Centre and The Ambulatory Care Centre today.

“The opening of our new building is the culmination of an extraordinary campaign of dedication and determination by a diverse group of professionals and volunteer leaders over the course of some 15 years,” said Norm Loberg, the chairman of the Board of Governors at The Credit Valley Hospital. “Their commitment and vision has truly made this building a place of healing and hope for patients with cancer, as well as all of those who will be treated in our ambulatory care facility.”

“We have a team of world-class medical personnel to ensure that our patients receive the most sophisticated treatment in an atmosphere conducive to their health and wellbeing,” said president and CEO Wayne Fyffe. “When we were developing the design for this building, we asked patients what they would like to see in a facility of this kind. They replied, ‘give us a building that will give us hope’ and that’s what we believe we have done, through the use of natural light, wood, warm colours and elements of nature that create an healing environment. We believe so strongly in our design, that we have been given a Change Foundation grant to study the impact of design on the healing process.”

The 330-thousand square ft. expansion effectively doubles the previous physical size of Credit Valley. The new addition devotes approximately one third of its space to cancer care, including radiation treatment - a first for the region, and the remaining two-thirds to ambulatory care – home to Credit Valley’s outpatient services. The new building’s interior design focuses on natural and comforting surroundings that offer patients and visitors an environment of healing and hope.

“We have raised \$40 million of our \$50 million capital campaign goal to support this expansion was unprecedented for its vision and target and ultimately for the support it garnered from the community that this hospital serves,” said Michael Murphy, Chair of the Credit Valley Hospital Foundation.

This \$134 million project is a collaborative effort between the Province of Ontario, the Region of Peel, the hospital and our donors.

The regional cancer program includes both systemic therapy and radiation treatment for patients in Peel, Halton, Dufferin, and regions beyond. The integrated ambulatory care centre will provide additional space for other critical ambulatory care programs such as cardiopulmonary, mental health, rehabilitation, diabetes education and our regional renal dialysis program.
