

Credit Valley Archival Wall

Unveiled November 5, 2005 (the hospital's 20th birthday)

The vertical sections of the original beams represent patients, visitors and caregivers, while the horizontal sections represent the intersection of community with the care provider. The long glass case has modern proportions and materials, with rounded edges to symbolize a time or medicine capsule.

The wall provides insight into some of the significant official events and historical events at Credit Valley. The wall facing us includes the official events and a visual journey through time through the IMAC computer. The other side of the wall – is our historical portion which marks significant milestones in our history.

Craftsmanship Dan Thompson designed and created this archival wall. Dan's work has places of prominence around the hospital – including our logo placed next to our main stage which was a focal point of our official opening in June...and our podiums that we use for official events.
